Subj: CONSTRUCTION BASIC VETERAN (CBVET) TECHNICAL TRAINING PROGRAM

1. Purpose. To establish procedures for providing technical training to personnel recruited for duty with the Naval Construction Force under the CBVET Program. The necessary entry level technical training will be provided to CBVETs to provide them with the construction skills required of a Navy Seabee. This notice provides guidance and prescribes FY00 training, which will allow CBVETs to attain required technical skills through participation in a formal course of instruction during Annual Training (AT) periods. It is not intended to supersede or modify existing requirements necessary for the CBVET's permanent Seabee rate designation.

2. Background. CBVETs are recruited from those individuals who have prior military service and they must have completed basic military training; however, technical construction skills training must be completed prior to being awarded a permanent Occupational Field 13 (OF-13) rating. The objective of the CBVET Technical Training Program is to provide CBVET recruits with the technical rating skills, familiarization, and knowledge similar to those of "A" school graduates (A-School equivalency program).

a. Prior Experience. All CBVET personnel are initially gained at an E3 or E4 pay grade with a temporary rating in one of six OF-13 source ratings: Builder (BU), Construction Electrician (CE), Construction Mechanic (CM), Equipment Operator (EO), Steelworker (SW), or Utilitiesman (UT). They are presumed to have little or no construction experience relevant to their new rating. They must have prior enlisted military experience in the United States Armed Forces (active or reserve).

b. Goal. The goal of the CBVET Technical Training Program is to familiarize and provide basic skills training in the safe usage of tools and equipment associated with the individual CBVET's chosen rating.

c. Completion. Each CBVET is provided with a QSB (reference (a)) for their chosen OF-13 rating. Per reference (b), the CBVET must complete reference (a) within a 24-month period. The 24-month period commences on the date the CBVET signs the applicable Administrative Remarks (NAVPERS 1070/613) Page 13 and receives the appropriate QSB.

3. Action. The CBVET is given the opportunity to attend two AT periods designed specifically for CBVET skills attainment and qualifications. These

AT periods will cover specific performance based topics of instruction that are normally difficult to obtain during weekend IDT periods. Formal training courses have been developed and will be offered through either NAVCONSTRACENS (Gulfport, MS and Port Hueneme, CA) or by the contractor. The two courses offered for each rate are independent from each other and may be taken in any order. The training schedule and locations are provided in enclosure (1). To ensure the CBVET is allowed every opportunity to attend the formal training, the following must be completed in a timely manner:

a. The Unit CBVET Coordinator will submit request for AT orders to the RSS Supervisor. In all cases, the POC (Block 11) will be identified as 20th NCR Quota Control. Orders will identify the following in Block 10C, Destination Location:

(1) For courses convening at NAVCONSTRACEN Gulfport, destination location is 20th NCR, CBC Gulfport, UIC 55460.

(2) For courses convening at NAVCONSTRACEN Port Hueneme, destination location is NAVCONSTRACEN, Port Hueneme, UIC 0612A.

(3) Use the following Course Identification Numbers (CIN)/Course Data Processing (CDP) codes for the CBVET Training:

NOTE: Unit CBVET Coordinators must identify at least three course option dates when submitting the Request for Training Orders (NAVRES 1571/15).

b. The RSS Supervisor will obtain quotas for CBVET personnel to attend formal training consistent with enclosure (1). If significant quota limitations are identified, quotas will be obtained for personnel based on seniority of entry into the CBVET program; i.e., date Page 13 was signed by the CBVET. If a quota is available, a copy of the Request for Training Orders (NAVRES 1571/15), signed by the applicant should be faxed to 20th NCR Quota Control. Point of Contact (POC) for obtaining training quotas is Quota Control at Commander, TWENTIETH Naval Construction Regiment (20th NCR), Naval Construction Battalion Center (CBC) Gulfport, who can be reached at 1-800-878-5867, Commercial (228) 871-2876, DSN 868-2876 or FAX (228) 871-2129.

c. CBVET Participants

(1) Working with the Detachment CBVET Coordinator, the CBVET will identify three course commencement dates that he/she will be able to attend. He/she will complete an AT application ensuring it is signed. The member's signature is necessary to ensure agreement with the time periods requested.


(a) Ensure Record of Emergency Data (NAVPERS 1070/602) (Page 2) is correct and update as necessary prior to checking out of the Reserve Center on AT.

(b) Report on the first day of AT in organizational clothing (CUUs).

(c) Report for training with QSB. All knowledge-based line items in the QSB must be signed off prior to attending a CBVET technical training course in order to allow maximum time for skills proficiency training.

(d) Advise their unit **immediately** if they are unable to attend a class after being enrolled.
